Section # 165-7

License fees shall be as follows:

- A. Peddlers; Ten (10.00) dollars per day; Fifty (50.00) dollars per week; One hundred (100.00) dollars per month and One hundred Fifty(150.00) dollars per year. Every peddler's license shall terminate at the close of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year which it was issued
- B. Solicitor; The sum of Five Hundred (500.00) Dollars for a license which shall continue in favor of the person to whom it is issued for the period of six (6) months from the date the same is issued
- C. Transient merchant; The amount prescribed by 165-7 B and, in addition therefore, the amount prescribed by 165-7A. for each peddler in his employ. The license shall continue in effect one year.

Section 165-10 (Penalties for offenses)

- A. Any person committing an offense against any provision of this chapter shall. Upon conviction thereof, be guilty of a violation pursuant to the penal Law of the Stet of New York, punishable by a fine not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty (250) dollars or by imprisonment. The continuation of an offense against the provisions of this chapter shall continue, for each day the offense is continues. A separate, distinct offense hereunder.
- B. In addition or as an alternative to above-provided penalties. The Town Board may also maintain as action or proceeding in the name of the Town in a court of competent jurisdiction to compel compliance with or to restrain by injunction the violation of this chapter.
