

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2019 the Town Board passed a Resolution authorizing the Town to enter into a Lease Agreement for a portion of the Town Barn property with Combined Energy Services and also passed a Resolution determining that a propane storage facility was a sufficiently similar use to a machinery storage use in the Rural Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, litigation was brought against the Town and Combined Energy Services challenging those Resolutions; and

WHEREAS, Combined Energy Services has informed the Town that it does not wish to go forward with the Planning Board application to construct a propane storage facility and does not wish to be involved in the litigation that was commenced against it and Town; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the foregoing, the two above Resolutions of February 11, 2019 have become moot;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board as follows:

That the two above-cited Resolutions of February 11, 2019 are hereby rescinded and are of no further force and effect.
