

TOWN OF CALLICOON
Special Town Board Meeting
December 16, 2021

The Town Board, Town of Callicoon, County of Sullivan, State of New York, at the Town Hall, held a Special Town Board Meeting on Thursday, December 16, 2021 at 3:30p.m., with the following present:

Supervisor T. Bose, Councilman C. Schadt, and Councilman S. Gaebel.

Supervisor Bose called the meeting to order with the pledge to the flag at 3:30 p.m.

This Special meeting is being held for the purpose of revising the list of Re-Levies of the Unpaid Metered and Unpaid UnMetered Water Bill Rents for the Youngsville Water District and anything else that comes before the Board.

The notice that was sent to Bold Gold Media, posted on the website and placed at various businesses in Youngsville was presented and read aloud.

RES#19, 2021, on a motion by Councilman Gaebel, seconded by Councilman Schadt to approve placing the 2021 Unpaid Unmetered Water Rents to be re-levied onto the 2022 Town & County Tax Bills in the amount of \$1,975.00. Motion Passed – 3 Ayes.

RES#20, 2021, on a motion by Councilman Gaebel, seconded by Councilman Schadt to approve placing the 2020 Unpaid Metered Water Rents to be re-levied onto the 2022 Town & County Tax Bills in the amount of \$3,310.10. Motion Passed – 3 Ayes.

Discussions included the amounts owed and discussed the Rates for the Water District. The proposed rate for usage is \$65.00, up from \$50.00. The proposed rate for usage over the allotted amount of 6250 gallons will go from \$8.00 per 1000 gallons over the allotted amount to \$9.50 per 1000 gallons over the allotted amount. The proposed late fee will go from 10% to 25%. The proposed rate of a New Installation will go from \$150.00 to \$500.00 plus the cost of excavating by the Water District, or by the user's own contractor, under the supervision of the water district superintendent.

On a motion by Councilman Gaebel, seconded by Councilman Schadt to adjourn the meeting at 3:51pm. Motion Passed – 3 Ayes.
