Supervisor Bose called the meeting to order with the Pledge to the Flag.

Highway Superintendent, Kris Scullion reports that he has 100 ton of salt on order, which if used it brings us to almost 1800 ton all together for the year. He also stated that he may order the full 2,000 tons to lock in for this year's price and hopefully do not use it all this year. He may do the same for the crusher run for the dirt roads from Deckelman to stock up on what we can before the prices go up. He hopes that asphalt prices are not that high.

Code Enforcement Officer, Kevin Zieres reports that permits are slowing down but not unusual for this time of year, but reports that house sales are still strong. Other than that it is quiet.
