Supervisor Bose called the meeting to order with the Pledge to the Flag.

REPORTS

Highway Superintendent, Kris Scullion reports that things are going good and they are getting ready for spring. They have been sweeping and switching bodies on the trucks. He noted that he has been in contact with the guy from AR Auctions and he is going to put several things on the auction including the 2011 dump body and the plow blade and the 2009 pick-up truck. He also stated that they have measured roads for blacktop and the price is about \$10.00 more per ton than last year. Once we receive the amounts from CHIPs, the Extreme Recovery, and PAVE, NY, we will know what roads we can do.

Code Enforcement Officer, Kevin Zieres reports that things are going good and that he has had a few garbage complaints but they are minor. He reports that he thinks it will be a busy year and noted that the price of houses are extremely high. The Supervisor noted that Kevin has spoken to the homeowner of the garbage complaint on Old Danzer Road and the homeowner said he will clean it up.

The Supervisor also noted the amount of garbage on the roads is unreal especially on State Route 52 between Youngsville and Jeffersonville and from Youngsville to White Sulphur Springs and noted that the Sullivan County Litter Pluck will run from April 1, 2022-June 30, 2022. There are stickers available for the bags to allow you to take the bags to any County Landfill for free. The Supervisor also mentioned reaching out to the Sullivan County Visitor's Association and Sullivan County to see if there is anything they can do about the situation.
